The Swedish Tech Leap



What is Tekniksprånget?

Tekniksprånget is a four-month paid internship programme intended to inspire and motivate more young people to study engineering. The internship gives them an insight into what an engineer's work involves and a vision for their studies. The programme takes place twice a year (autumn/spring).

Why Tekniksprånget?

The rapid development of technology has dramatically changed the conditions in the job market. The need for technical knowledge and expertise has never been greater and the competition for engineers is getting tougher. To meet future challenges and recruitment needs, more young people need to study for an engineering degree. This is where Tekniksprånget comes in.

Tekniksprånget is making a difference!

Since 2012, over 7,000 young people have completed internships through Tekniksprånget – half of them women. Tekniksprånget works purposefully with diversity by targeting young people born abroad and young people from homes with no tradition of higher education. Tekniksprånget motivates young people to apply for – and complete – higher technical education, once they have gained a clear picture of what the education leads to.

Post-internship feedback:

- 9 out of 10 who continue to higher education study technology or natural sciences.
- Half of those who continue their studies are women.
- 94 percent would recommend Tekniksprånget to a friend.

Who can apply for an internship?

Tekniksprånget is aimed at students (18–21 years of age) who have completed an upper secondary science, technology, economics or IB-programme.

What does being a partner involve?

As a Tekniksprånget partner you have the chance to impact young people's choices and forge valuable relationships with the workforce of the future.

You choose how many and who you want to offer an internship to. You undertake to:

- Provide mentors
- Recruit the interns
- Pay an intern salary for four months

Our participating partners range from fast-growing IT companies to multinational industrial corporations and government agencies.
